

Smoking at Tunkuwallin Reserve

Amendments to the Smoke-free Environment Act 2000, came into effect on 07/01/2013 which prohibits smoking within certain public areas.

Smoke-free Environment Act 2000 No 69

Section 6A Smoke-free areas—outdoor public places

- (1) *An outdoor public place is a **smoke-free area** for the purposes of this Act if it is any of the following places (or part of any of those places):*
- (c) *an area set aside for or being used by spectators to watch an organised sporting event at a sports ground or other recreational area, but only when an organised sporting event is being held there*

The Act also allows local councils to introduce their own regulations, accordingly Wyong Shire Council have designated the Tunkuwallin Oval reserve as a smoke free zone
